The Lord's Prayer  
Thanksgiving Prayer  
Welcome New Comers  
Worship with Responsive Reading  
Worship with Scripture Reading
- 11:35am **Worship with God's Message**
- 12:05am Announcements & Closing Prayer

Be sure to prepare:

\***Group Introduction** (name and purpose of the community/fellowship group, names of each person, a short ice breaker or games related to the community group (optional),...etc.)

\***Call to Worship** (reading a scripture from the Word) – lead by person in your group leading songs

\*Worship through **Singing** (lead 3 to 5 songs)

\*Worship through **Message, Skit, and/or Story telling** (be creative; message can be a short explanation of skit; be sure to include a related scripture)

- The children in this worship service age range are 6 years old to 12 year olds. So please choose some songs that the younger children can relate to or are easier to sing (songs with repeating verses are good). If possible, using hand motion will help the younger ones to participate and worship God.
- Have fun with the children. Example: Quiz them before you leave to see if they remember your faces/names or what you taught (prizes are optional).
- Worship will begin at 10:45AM and end around 12:00PM.
- Be ready to lead a game or another song if the skit, story telling or message runs short.
