Seeing this need, National Tsing-Hua University (NTHU), one of Taiwan's most prestigious universities, has designed a high-quality International Students Summer Camp program as a platform for facilitating collaboration and networking among students and teachers worldwide. The whole camp will be conducted in English. International teachers are expected to design and lead camp during the two-week program. International students will mingle with local students and serve as teaching assistants. An optional tour around Taiwan will happen in the third week if there is enough interest.

The application is open for all candidates until 4/15/2006. NTHU will cover airfare, living expenses, and also pay teaching hours at the market rate to eligible teachers. For qualified international students, NTHU plans to offer scholarship to cover airfare, food and lodge expenses. Group applications are welcome.

## Appendix:

1. **Visa** - Taiwan Regulation of Visa-Exempt Entry and Landing Visas for Foreigners: Please check out official Taiwan Ministry of Foreign Affairs web site <http://www.boca.gov.tw/ct.asp?xItem=1443&ctNode=116&mp=2> for latest update. Citizens from most foreign countries (e.g. US, UK, etc.) are granted 30 days visa exempt entry.
2. **Medical insurance:** The program participants (teachers and students) will be covered for accidental bodily injury up to the last day of the summer camp. The coverage of medical expenses is limited and does not include medical repatriation. International student or teacher should make sure his or her own health insurance policy does include medical repatriation in case of becoming seriously ill or injured and needing to be accompanied home with medical professionals.
